### **DAILY PROMISES**

**DAY 1:** Read Joshua 1:1 - 9. Underline any words that remind you not to be afraid. What was the specific promise of God in these verses? Write it out and memorize that verse.

**DAY 2:** Read Ephesians 1. Underline some of the words in this chapter that mean the same thing as “promises” or “promise”. Enjoy this chapter. You might want to read it a couple of times for encouragement today.

**DAY 3:** Read Hebrews 4:14-16 and Hebrews 13:1-8. Why is it hard for Christians to enter into God’s presence “boldly”? Why can we be confident when we come to Him?

**DAY 4:** Read II Timothy 2:1-13. What is the most meaningful verse to you in these Scriptures? Look for an opportunity to share this scripture with someone today.

**DAY 5:** Read Romans 10:1-17; Romans 9:33. What has been your biggest disappointment in life? How has God shown Himself faithful in spite of your disappointment?

**DAY 6:** Read John 14 and Matthew 28:20. Do you always “feel” God’s presence? What should you do during those moments when you need Him but may not “feel” Him? Write out a prayer that you could pray when you feel alone and yet know that God is near.

**DAY 7:** Read Joshua 1:10-18. Why is it dangerous to stay on the outside of God’s promises for your life? In what practical way do God’s promises have the power to protect you from the enemy?
