DAILY PROMISES

DAY 1: Read II Corinthians 1:12-22. Make a list of the ways that your life brings glory to God. List 10 questions that Jesus answers with a resounding, "YES!"

DAY 2: Read I John 1:8-10; Psalm 103:1-14. According to I John, what do we need to do in order to be forgiven? Why is it important to know how to be forgiven? Why is it important to know that you are forgiven?

DAY 3: Read Isaiah 43:25; Ephesians 1:3-8. What was the price that Jesus paid for your forgiveness? In the Ephesians' reading, underline the following words: blessed, blessing, chose, holy, blameless, love, adoption, kind, freely, forgiveness, riches, grace, lavished. How do these words make you feel?

DAY 4: Read Acts 16: 29-34; Romans 10:9-11; Titus 3:4-7. Choose some significant words to underline in the Titus' reading. Are any of these words similar or the same as the ones that you underlined yesterday in the Ephesians' reading?

DAY 5: Read John 10:22-30; John 6:41-48. What must you do to cash in on the promise of eternal life? Look up the word "believe" in a dictionary and write down the definition.

DAY 6: Read I John 2:15-26; John 3:16; John 11:17-26. Jesus asked Martha if she believed Him. Why is it important to tell Jesus whether or not we believe His promises? Is there a difference between just saying an internal "yes" and declaring it out loud? Why or why not?

DAY 7: Read Psalm 51. Underline some of your favorite words in this Psalm. Meditate and pray over verses 10-13. What did the Holy Spirit say to you?
